

## **Architecturae et Artibus**

### **Editorial and Publishing Policy**

1. Architecturae et Artibus journal is a quarterly published by the Bialystok University of Technology Publishing House based on order of the Faculty of Architecture.
2. Faculty of Architecture bears the costs of publishing. However, the Rector of the Bialystok University of Technology may decide to co-finance the magazine from his/her resources. The journal may also be subsidized by an adequate ministerial department or from other sources.
3. In the case of publishing works sent to the conference or materials of scientific workshops in the journal issue, the editor-in-chief may ask the organizers to refund part or all of the costs of issuing this number under a separate agreement.
4. Thematic scope of the journal includes the following areas: architecture and town planning (especially including: architecture, town planning, spatial planning, regional planning, rural architecture and planning, landscape architecture, green design, history and theory of architecture and town development, preservation and conservation of historic monuments), fine arts and design.
5. Articles shall be sent to the editorial board by electronic system (as doc/docx files), in compliance with the official form published on the website of the journal (file: Paper template). The references cited have to be in alphabetical order, unnumbered according to APA style.
6. Submitted manuscripts shall be written in English, Polish or Russian and have to contain title and abstract in English.
7. Editor-in-chief (or deputy editor-in-chief) check the compatibility of the article to thematic scope of the journal and transfer it to thematic editor of the appropriate discipline.
8. Thematic Editor proposes the candidates for reviewers and, if necessary, verifies authors' compliance with the conditions stated in the reviews and approves or disapproves the manuscript for printing.
9. Editor-in-chief (or deputy) has a right to choose of reviewers and to check the compliance of papers with the conditions stated in the reviews. In reasonable cases editor-in-chief (or deputy) can transfer these rights to member of the Scientific Board of the journal – the expert of specific thematic scope.
10. Submitted manuscripts are peer-reviewed. A manuscript must obtain two positive reviews by independent experts external to the institution of author's affiliation, before being accepted for publication. Authors and reviewers doesn't know each other (double blind peer-review).
11. Submission of a manuscript implies that the work described has not been published previously and that it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere and author

dispose of necessary copyrights for all components of the article: text, tables, figures. Authors of a submitted manuscript must sign a declaration confirming that (file: Confirmation).

12. The Editorial Board of the journal recognize the authors of the work as persons who contributed to the creation of the publication (substantive contribution). The data of these persons, together with their affiliation, should be placed in the head part of the article. In the case of in-kind and financial contributions, etc. an entity other than the authors, the name of the person or institution should be included in the acknowledgments contained in the publication. It is unacceptable to mention as the author of the person whose participation in the creation of the publication did not take place or was negligible.
13. The authors submitting the article are obliged to provide the Editorial Board with written information on the contribution of individual authors to the creation of publication, as well as the contribution of scientific and research institutions, associations and other entities. It is a condition of publication that authors assign copyright or license the publication rights in their articles, including abstracts, to Bialystok University of Technology (file: Confirmation 2).
14. The authors are obliged to comply with the principles of ethics and copyright of third parties. Attempts at scientific misconduct, in particular falsification of research or scientific results or other scientific fraud, violations of the Copyright and Related Rights Act, violation and violation of ethical principles in science are unacceptable. The editors make efforts to eliminate this kind of practice.
15. The editor-in-chief (or his deputy) takes the final decision regarding the acceptance of the article for publishing.
16. Once a year, a list of reviewers who reviewed the works submitted for publication in a given year is published in the last issue of the journal. The list of reviewers is also published on the journal's website ([www.aeawa.pb.edu.pl](http://www.aeawa.pb.edu.pl)).
17. The editor-in-chief (or his deputy) may decide to publish a polemic or discussion sent to the editor regarding articles printed in the journal. The journal may also contain book reviews, conference reports or advertising materials.
18. All issues of the journal are published in print and electronic versions ([www.aeawa.pb.edu.pl](http://www.aeawa.pb.edu.pl)). The reference version is the print one.
