Guidelines for the Authors

1. Technical aspect

Texts should be sent in electronic form, in .doc/docx format in English or Polish, and in justified cases, in Russian. The text layout complies with the guidelines in the Paper template file.

2. Thematic scope

Pursuant to the regulations of the journal Architecturae et Artibus, articles submitted for publication should cover issues related to the magazine's profile, i.e.:

- architecture, town planning (including: history and theory of architecture and town development, preservation and conservation of historic monuments, rural architecture and planning);

- spatial planning;
- regional planning;
- landscape architecture and green design;
- fine arts;
- design.

3. Substantive content

Submitted texts should discuss current issues in a way that takes into account the current state of knowledge. They should present original research results achieved through scientific methods. Authors of works should correctly use scientific terminology from a given discipline.

4. Text structure

Title - it should correspond to the content of the work and signal the research problem discussed in the text.

Title and abstract in English

Summary - should clearly describe the methods used and the results obtained.

Keywords - keywords in English and in language of an article

Introduction - it should present, among others work goals.

Conclusions - should be justified in the content of the work.

Literature - the cited literature should be selected in a relevant and sufficient way, just like the illustrative material. Literature listed in an alphabetical order typed in Roman alphabet.

5. Other requirements

The condition for publishing the article is its positive review and transfer to the editors of the signed statement that the author has full copyright to the text and illustrations contained in the submitted article.
